## OPERATIONS



Marmaris Cruise Port employs two experienced pilots and a modern tug. As well as pilotage and towage, our port provides high pressure fresh water and can collect various types of waste to its licenced waste reception facility. When necessary, tendering operations can smoothly be carried out by ship or shore tenders docking at designated parts of the piers.

## ISPS

Marmaris Cruise Port complies fully with all the requirements of the ISPS code, providing a very secure environment both for passengers and cruise vessels. The Coast Guard headquarters for South-West Turkey is situated right adjacent to the port. Marmaris Cruise Port Security Officer is constantly in contact with the Coast Guard Base regarding the cruise traffic in Marmaris.



## PASSENGER TERMINAL



The newly renovated passenger terminal is located at the end of the pier and offers a wide range of services and amenities for passengers such as public telephones, restrooms, tourism information desk, immigration, health, security and customs offices. The terminal building is fully air-conditioned and there are security X-ray machines and metal detectors for passengers and luggage at the entrance.





## CHECK-IN SALOON



The newly built check-in saloon is located opposite the passenger terminal. The fully air-conditioned check-in saloon has two welcoming desks near the entrance and there are in total 12 check-in counters offering passengers to complete their embarkation procedures smoothly. All desks have 220 V European type plugs as well as high speed Wi-Fi connection.



## TURNAROUND OPERATIONS

Thomson Celebration & The World



Thomson Cruises has selected Marmaris Cruise Port as homeport for its 1350 passengers capacity cruise ship "Thomson Celebration" in 2010. The vessel makes 26 turnaround calls in Marmaris annually. Marmaris Cruise Port has undergone major renovation and improved its facilities in time for the turn-around operations. Improvements include; a new check-in facility, road and pier resurfacing, new pavements and extensive additional shade awnings around the check-in hall, in the coach park area and on the piers.

Cruise passengers arriving by air at nearby Dalaman Airport can enjoy a smooth passage to the Sea Port thanks to designated immigration counters dedicated for cruise passengers at the airport terminal.

## MARMARIS TOWN & SIGHTSEEING OPPORTUNITIES



Marmaris, the ancient Physcus, was an important town on the Anatolia-Rhodes-Egypt trade route. The history of Marmaris dates back to 3400 BC and traces of different civilisations can still be seen in the area. Due to its natural protective nature, the harbour has played an important role in naval history and provided shelter to the fleet of Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent during his conquest of Rhodes in 1522. Admiral Nelson also assembled his fleet here before sailing to Egypt in 1798. Today the town remains important as an attractive, modern holiday resort and the leading yachting hub of the Eastern Mediterranean, with its marinas home to yachts from all over the world. The port is 10 minutes scenic walk from Marmaris town centre.
